What

Parent survey

-encourage parent involvement with an assessment of skills and resources

Why:

- Allows a group or section to enhance its features in the program by allowing youth family members to contribute personal skill sets or resources.

What do I Need

- The section specific program standards to provide the parents to show what is expected at each section level and the Parent resource survey found on the SWO web site where they may find ideas on how they could contribute.

Who Do I Need

- The group committee, service scouters and section leaders, these are the people who can distribute the survey and encourage parents to fill one out. The leadership team will understand and best be able to direct and implement the results.

Preparation

- The group committee and section leaders should review early on the groups program needs and areas where contribution to the program could be enhanced and continually seek help through dialogue with parents.

How do I do it

- Starting with registration and continuing through out the year ask and encourage parents to be come involved and contribute if they show compatible interests with the program standards.

Follow-up:

- The group committee should follow up any interests with encouragement to participate and thank those annually who contribute, perhaps at the Scout week banquet or during a sponsor/partner function.
